The Playhouse West Film Festival is well known as one of the most positive, filmmaker-friendly festivals in the country. Each year we hear from more and more filmmakers that our festival has been their favorite. From our well organized, run-on-time format, to our unique Q&A's after each screening block, giving filmmakers a platform to discuss their films at length with our audience, we take great pride in making our festival a fantastic experience for filmmakers.

As an institution, Playhouse West leads the way in encouraging young filmmakers. Playhouse West members from Los Angeles and Philadelphia produce over 250 films per year, many which go on to be accepted and win awards at film festivals around the country and world.






